Today, Sunday 7 September, Pope Leo XIV is due to canonise two young Italians—Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati.

Carlo Acutis died of leukaemia in 2005 at the age of 15, and is remembered for his kindness, especially to the poor and lonely, including friends and classmates who were struggling in one way or another. He faith in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist was, in his own words, his "Highway to Heaven." He was also devoted to the Rosary. An expert on the computer—he created a website devoted to miracles associated with the Blessed Sacrament—he has been dubbed the Patron Saint of the internet, and has already been called "The First Millennial Saint."

Pier Giorgio Frassati died of polio in 1925 at the age of 24. An avid mountaineer and sportsman, he is remembered for his charitable outreach to the poor and the sick. He worked to bring people together in fellowship in an effort to combat inequality. He was particularly kind to the poor and needy, and a member of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society. On one occasion when a mother and child called at his house he saw that the child had no shoes, so he took off his shoes and gave them to him. He is Patron of Students, Young Catholics, Mountaineers, and World Youth Day.
