Sun 12th May we are hosting a Big Breakfast from 8-12 Noon in the club.

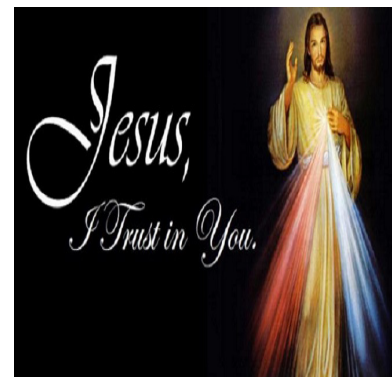
