ADVICE FROM HEALTH AUTHORITIES

(re : Corona Virus (COVID-19) outbreak)

We suggest that physical interaction during or after religious services, including the Sign of Peace

The practice of shaking hands on greeting and departure at religious services/ gatherings should be suspended for both religious leaders/clergy and laity.

Holy water fonts should not be used.

Holy Communion in the hand, rather than on the tongue.

The chalice should not be shared with others:- concelebrants, Eucharistic Ministers or any member of the congregation.

The general advice is that we all exercise caution and ensure good hygiene practices.
