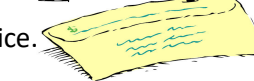

You cannot place in a funeral notice:

Details of the funeral service (where/when)

Details of any committal (where/when)

Anything encouraging mourners to line the route

Anything encouraging mourners to visit the family home.

Both regulations and guidance currently state that under the general "stay at home" lockdown rules "you are not permitted leave the place where you are living unless you have a reasonable excuse to do so."
