Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage,

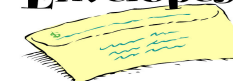
and defend us from every evil. Amen.

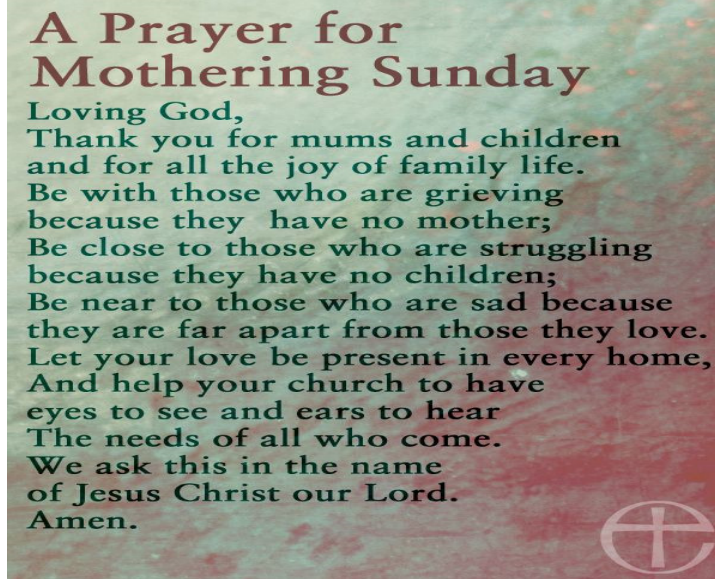
