Month's Mind and First Anniversary Masses may be celebrated at different times, but other anniversaries will be celebrated at the scheduled weekend or weekday Masses.

Preparing for Christmas with the Scriptures: The readings for Advent and Christmas invite us to celebrate the coming of Jesus Christ into the world as our Lord and Saviour. If you would like to take a prayerful look at the Sunday readings, there will be a meeting in the Prayer Room at St Mary's Church, Bellaghy, on the next five Mondays, beginning at 7.30pm.
