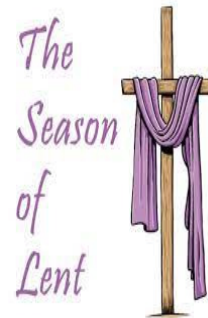

- Abstaining from meat or some other food.
- Abstaining from alcoholic drink or smoking.
- Making special effort at involvement in family prayer.
- Making an effort to participate in Mass on Fridays.
- Visiting the Blessed Sacrament.
- Making the Stations of the Cross.
- Helping the poor, sick, old or lonely.
- Fasting from all food for a longer period than usual and perhaps giving what is saved to the needy.
