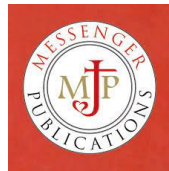

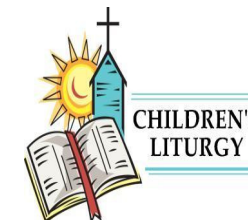


**We are currently recruiting Readers and Eucharistic Ministers**
