**Preparing for Holy Year 2025—Pilgrims of Hope.**

**The Creed** is our opportunity to stand up and profess our faith in God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It reminds us also of the role of Mary, the Mother of Jesus in the story of Salvation, and it invites us to cherish the fact that we are part of the universal Church, and that we share the same faith with more than a billion people around the world.

**The Intercessions** are the expression of some of our needs as a Church, as a diocese, and as a parish community. There should, as least occasionally, be a time of quiet prayer for us to express our own thoughts and prayers at this time.

**The Eucharistic Prayer** is the time when the bread and wine that have been offered become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Saviour. It's a time for active listening to the words spoken by the priest as he calls on the Holy Spirit to make Jesus present to us and for us. **The "Mystery of Faith"** is an acclamation we should make fervently and enthusiastically as it professes something very important about our belief in who Jesus is, in what He has done, and continues to do for us.
