It may be possible during the course of this Holy Year of Hope to introduce the celebration of the Liturgy of the Hours in our churches, perhaps before Mass on occasional



weekdays and, if the need should ever arise, in the event of there being no priest available to celebrate Mass. At present we do it in our parishes on the mornings of the Easter Triduum—Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday when there is no celebration of Mass in any of our churches or parishes. In the meantime, we may be able to use a suitable app (e.g. Universalis) for reciting the various Hours. It may even be possible to gather with family members, neighbours, or friends to pray the Psalms etc. together.
