This Lent, we ask you to join with us in our Parish Lenten focus:

RESTORING THE JOY OF REVERENCE whilst inside the chapel.

Let us make Christ the central focus of all we say and do whilst we are before Him in the Tabernacle. Please join with us in the following:

SILENCE IN THE CHAPEL – remember we are in the presence of Christ in the Tabernacle. Let us work together to be present in the presence of Christ in prayerful silence.

PRAYER— use the silence in the chapel when we are before Christ in the Tabernacle, to listen to and hear God speak to us. Let us use this prayerful silence to speak to Him and bring our needs to Him.

RESPECT – be respectful and reverent in the chapel. Let us be mindful that there are others who wish to use this time to speak quietly to Jesus as He resides in the Tabernacle. **GENUFLECT** – remember to genuflect as we enter and leave our seats – a simple but powerful way to acknowledge, worship, honour and humble ourselves before the Christ our Saviour, present before us in the Tabernacle.

REVERENCE & AWE - are gifts of the Holy Spirit. May we strive to use the gifts of the Holy Spirit this Lent, each time we gather before Christ in the Tabernacle, to bring us closer to Him. **BLESSING OURSELVES** - when we enter and leave the chapel, when we receive Christ in the Eucharist, let us take the time to bless ourselves properly by making the Sign of the Cross, as a personal act of piety and reverence.

Eucharistic Adoration, which takes place in both of our parishes - in Greenlough on Thursdays from 9am - 5pm, and in Bellaghy on Fridays from 10am - 7/8pm - is a wonderful opportunity for us to spend time in the presence of Jesus who makes Himself present to us in the Eucharist, whether or not the Blessed Sacrament is exposed. Adoration prolongs and gives more space for a personal encounter with Jesus outside of the time of Mass. It's like accepting the invitation of Jesus to the disciples in the Garden of Gethsemani to "spend one hour with me". It's a time for silent prayer, being still in the presence of our Lord and Saviour and giving meaning to our lives as Christians. The Eucharist is food and nourishment for our spiritual journey through life and is designed to make us holy, God's people.
